

Los Riscos Walk (The Walk of the Eras).

(Walking from hotel about 4 hours; From Juzcar junction about 2.5 hours; from Car Park 1.5 hours)

Take the road (or track if walking) to Juzcar.

At the first turnoff turn right, and right again signposted Los Riscos.

If driving you may wish to park here to lengthen the walk by about 40-50 min.

The track is quite drivable, a bit bumpy at the bottom but concrete from halfway up.

At the top is a car park on the left.

The walk starts and finishes opposite the car park.

The start and finish of the walk are a few metres apart with the start on the right, a track leading to a gate after about 30 metres, the finish a gate in the fence with a ramp down to the track.

Take the track on the right and continue up until you come to a notice illustrating the use of an Era (ancient threshing circle).

Turn left in front of the notice and you will find the track marked by stones and small posts with arrows.

You will pass through a gate and shortly climb up through the rocks until you get to a formation called The Eagle. Not far beyond the Eagle sign you must turn left, not too clear. The path passes through a couple of ridges, goes fairly straight for a short distance and then bears around to the left. You are circling the peak that is now hiding the car park and drops back down the the exit gate.

The return is the reverse of your outward journey
